### 1. Responsibilities:

#### In the Classroom

- Following guidance from teaching staff to deliver learning activities to pupils/classes in line with departmental schemes of work
- Working with small groups of pupils to personalise, develop and enhance their learning
- Supporting teachers by leading and delivering intervention plans on a one-to-one basis across both key stages
- Working with teachers to deliver improvements in progress at KS3 and KS4
- Conducting SEND specific assessments as directed by the SEND Management Team

#### In the Hub/Cabin

- Ensuring that provision and interventions outlined in student EHCPs are being implemented effectively with outcomes and impact recorded to provide information for the annual review process
- Support the Cabin team lead to ensure staff are allocated appropriately in conjunction with the SENDCo – both for in class support, delivering interventions and as keyworkers for individual students
- Providing guidance to teachers and other staff on how best to support targeted students

### 2. Professional Values and Practice:

- Having high expectations of all pupils; respecting their social, cultural, linguistic, religious and ethnic backgrounds; and being committed to supporting them to achieve in line with their potential
- Treating pupils consistently with respect and consideration, and being concerned with their development as learners
- In line with the Trust's policy and procedures, using behaviour management strategies which contribute to a purposeful learning environment
- Working collaboratively with colleagues as part of a professional team; and carrying out roles effectively, knowing when to seek help and advice from colleagues
- Reflecting upon and seeking to improve personal practice
- Building and maintaining successful relationships with pupils, parents/carers and staff including ensuring at least weekly communication from keyworkers

### **3. Support for pupils by:**

- Liaising sensitively and effectively with parents and carers with regard to their role in pupil learning
- Having sufficient understanding of the curriculum and identified interventions to support pupils' learning effectively – requesting training and guidance if required
- Being familiar with age related expectations of pupils, the main teaching methods and the assessment framework in the relevant subject/specialisms/age groups
- Understanding how to use common ICT tools to advance pupils' learning
- Promoting and reinforcing pupils' self esteem

### **4. Support for the teacher by:**

- Contributing to planning and preparation of lessons and providing feedback to pupils and colleagues concerning learning and behaviour
- Providing scaffolding to support and contributing effectively to the selection and preparation of teaching resources that meet the diversity of pupils' needs and interests
- Evaluating pupil progress through a range of assessment activities and monitoring pupil participation, progress and responses to learning

### **5. Support for the curriculum by:**

- Understanding the aims and content of teaching strategies and intended outcomes, and their place in the related teaching programme
- Understanding the key factors which affect the way pupils learn
- Being familiar with the guidance about meeting special educational needs given in the Code of Practice

### **6. Other Responsibilities**

- Keeping up to date with the necessary policies, procedures, rules and regulations laid down by the different examination bodies
- Playing a full part in the life of the Trust and College community, to support its distinctive vision and ethos and to encourage staff and students to follow this example.
- Promoting the Trust's corporate policies
- Complying with the Trust's Health & Safety Policy
- Participating in the College's appraisal scheme
